We want all Territorian cyclists, including sporting, commuters and recreational riders, to join us on a cycling adventure.

1 DAY - 146km

Pedal away on Sunday 8 August 2010

This is a community participation event, not a race. You can just enjoy the ride with other cyclists and the satisfaction of accomplishment.

Riders are self seeded at the start, meaning riders who plan to cycle the same speed as you will start together. This will promote people enjoying riding together and getting to know other riders of similar ability. Please indicate when registering what speed group you will cycle in; 20-25km/hr, 25-30km/hr, 30-35km/hr, 35km/hr+.

You can register in different categories:

- **INDIVIDUAL**
- **TEAM RELAY (maximum of 4)**
- **CORPORATE CHALLENGE (maximum of 4)**
- **JUNIORS (14+ to 17 years old)**

We've added all the ingredients; Early 6am start with minimal highway traffic, quiet rural roads, blue skies and sunny day, cold drink and snack stop points along the way, safety cars and safety signs, on course first aid and return trip back to Darwin via the charter boat or the Madnorah Ferry, everything you would expect of a well organised group ride.

Your family and friends can meet you at the local Mandorah Pub where they will be well catered for, beach frontage, pool, lunch from 11.30am till 2pm and local entertainment.
